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BEFORE WE START

HOW THIS SESSION WORKS.

Three modes, one goal. Every block ends with something real running on your own laptop — so use your own business problems and documents, not sample data.

TEACH

SHORT, THEN STRAIGHT TO THE DOING.

No block is more than a few minutes of explanation before you are building. If something is unclear, say so immediately — the concepts stack.

LIVE DEMO

WATCH IT BUILT ONCE, IN FULL.

We build against real tools, live and unedited. You will see the false starts too, because that is what the work actually looks like.

TEAM BUILD

THE TOOLS ON THE TABLE.

WISPR FLOW IN SESSION

Voice dictation in any app — talk your prompts instead of typing them.



CLAUDE DESKTOP IN SESSION

The AI workbench — chat, connectors, and Cowork on your real files.



HEYCLICKY IN SESSION

Screen-aware AI beside your cursor — sees what you see, guides you live.



PLAUD

Wearable recorder — every meeting and drive-time idea captured and summarized.



NOTION AI MEETING NOTETAKER

Joins the call, writes the notes, files them where the work lives.



CODEx

A software engineering agent — describe the change, review the shipped code.



RELEVANCE AI

Build a team of AI agents for sales, research and ops — no engineers needed.



PERPLEXITY COMET

A browser with AI built in — it reads, compares and acts across tabs for you.



HERMES AGENT

A background agent on recurring watch — scans, digests, and reports on schedule.

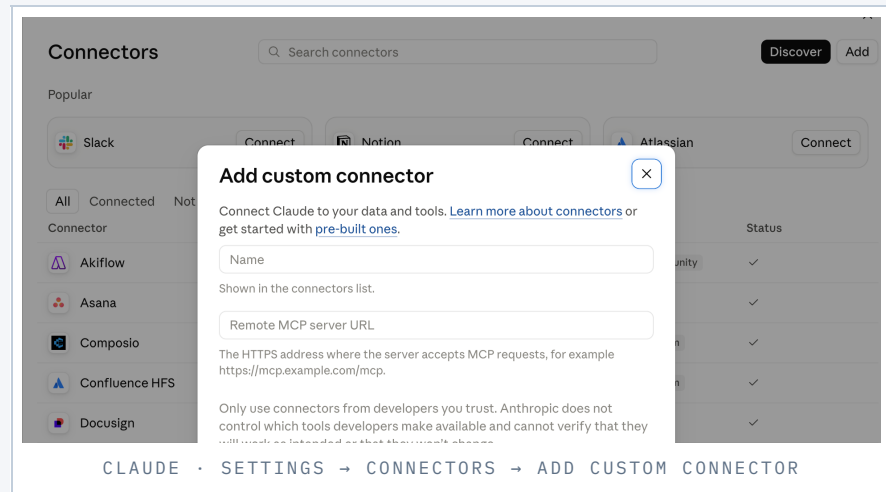

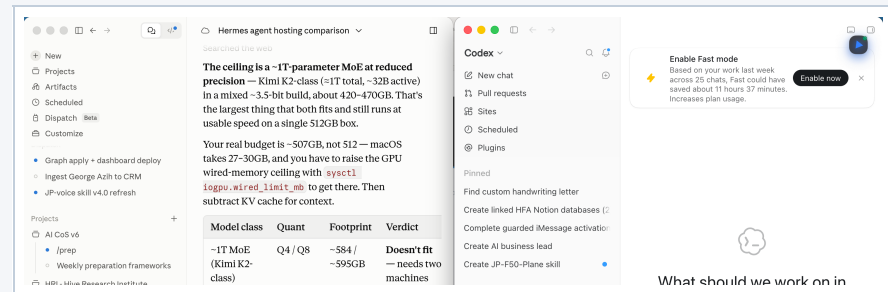
